PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE:

Hurricane Season Along the Texas Gulf

Society of American Military Engineers is all about Readiness. As I watched Irene, I wondered if the East Coasters were ready. I wondered what their response would be. I recalled the impacts of hurricanes to our Texas economy and our response to the damage that hurricanes left on our communities in the past.

The Event. 1900 Hurricane, Nicknamed the "Great Storm" with winds estimated at 130-140 mph, crossed Galveston Island Sept 8, 1900. At that point the highest point on The Island was 8.7 feet high – Storm Surge elevation was 15.7 feet high. There were approximately 6,000 deaths and 3,600 buildings were destroyed. The response to that storm was the Seawall. It was built to protect The Island from future hurricanes. Construction began in 1902 and was completed in 1962. (Does someone have a calculator...60 years to finish...right?). The Seawall extends 7 miles along the Galveston Coast and is 17 feet high; the cost of the seawall was almost \$15.5M.

The Event. Carla, Hit the Texas Coastline on September 10, 1961. Winds reached as high as 170 mph in Port Lavaca. Storm Surge elevation measured 22 feet . 46 Souls were lost that day. The Response was the Texas City Dike with Construction of Levees in Texas City beginning in 1962 ONLY a year after Hurricane Carla. The idea was to protect the refineries along the Houston Galveston Ship Channel. Construction was completed in 1982. (Now, where is that calculator.. that would be 21 years. Is there anyone out there that can do QC on the calc..?). The TCD now provides protection for 36 square miles from hurricane storm surge elevation of 15 feet.

The Event. Hurricane Ike. The eye of the storm went over Galveston Island, Texas on September 13, 2008. (My house was only 7 Miles off centerline). It had maximum sustained winds of 145 mph. Maximum storm surge height was 15-20 feet. 200+ lives lost, Cost of damage approximately \$30B and it was 3rd largest financial loss from a natural disaster in history of US.
