PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE: GROWTH AND PERFORMANCE

A new year has begun for the Post. Yes, July is the start of our new year. At our Installation and Awards Banquet in June, a new board took office to coincide with the beginning of our 2009-2010 year. Awards were presented to HNTB and Midtown Engineers, our Sustaining Member Firms of the Year, and to Joe Myers, our Outstanding Member of the Year. Mattress Mack was our featured speaker and provided a moving account of the fire that destroyed his life's work. His was a story of tragedy, heroics, determination and hope.

I again want to thank the 2008-2009 Officers, Directors and Committee Chairs for their extended term of service through all of 2008 and half of 2009. Their leadership was noted by many, including SAME National, as we received Streamers for Education / Training and Relationships / Recognition, and Streamers with Distinction for Readiness / Homeland Security and Outreach / Communication. A job well done indeed!

As I stated at the June Banquet, we will focus on two specific areas in the upcoming year: growth and performance.

GROWTH

This year we will grow the Post. I say this with full confidence knowing the Past Presidents & Fellows Council is fully committed to this initiative. We presently have 66 Sustaining Member Organizations, 269 members within these organizations, 123 individual members, and 107 student members. This adds up to 499 members in all. The National goal for growth is five (5) percent, but I believe we need to set our sights higher. I will discuss specific goals with the PP&FC, but I believe we should strive for ten (10) percent growth over the next twelve months. That means 7 new sustaining member organizations, 13 new individual members, and 11 new student members.

Growth is the vehicle for opportunity. Growth provides opportunity for expanded networks of business associates. Growth provides opportunities for emerging leaders to develop their skills. Growth provides opportunities for personal and professional development. These are opportunities for membership that we must create to ensure our long term sustainability.

The purpose of TRRN is to aid in response and planning efforts by allowing system users to access resource information. Basically, it is an electronic inventory system for available resources and equipment for use by emergency management organizations throughout Texas.
